Volunteers for Gritting and Salting Pavements and Roads

The Emergency Planning Group are taking advantage of assistance from Devon County Council to purchase gritting/salting equipment to be used locally on pavements and roads not treated by DCC in extreme weather conditions. The equipment is designed to be towed by a 4-wheel drive vehicle, quad bike or tractor and volunteers with suitable vehicles will be needed to help make sure everyone can get about safely in the icy conditions we experienced last year.

As part of the Emergency Planning Group, Bampton Town Council's Snow Warden will be co-ordinating the gritting and salting in the event of bad weather. Please contact the Town Clerk if you can help in any way to keep your local area safe and accessible. Training and Insurance is available.
