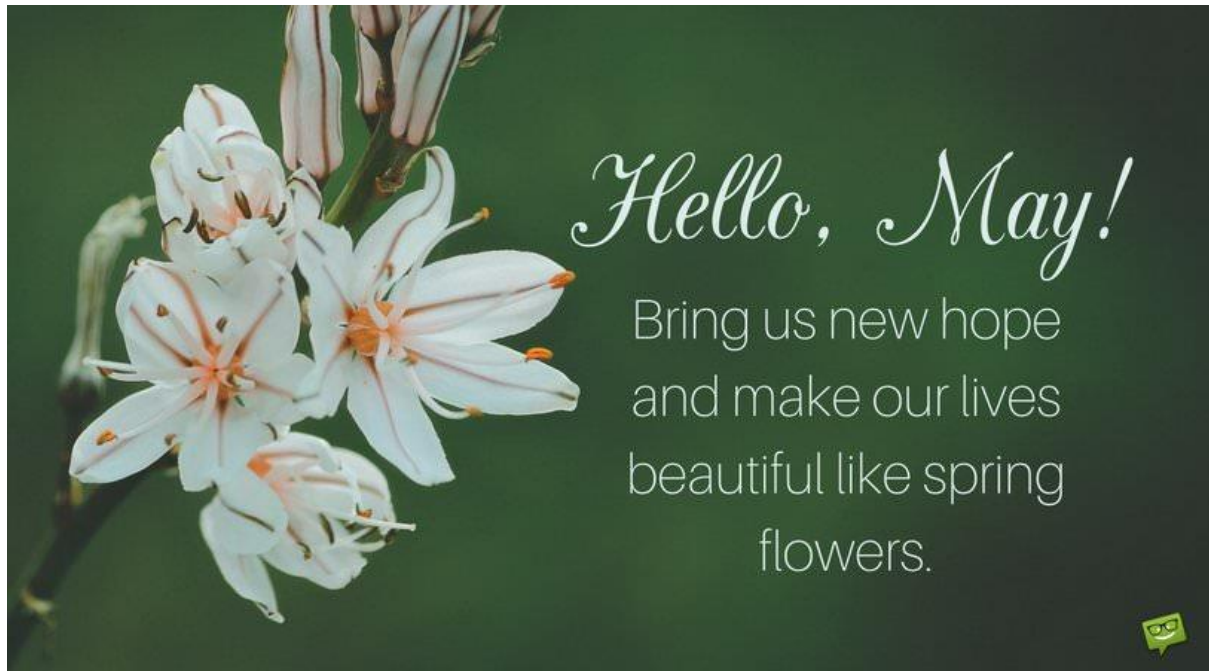


Bampton Players Newsletter - May 2021
